After graduating from Harpursville High School, Lester R. Stone served as a Sergeant, U.S. Army, 1st Platoon, Company B, 1st Battalion, 20th Infantry, 11th Infantry Brigade, 23d Infantry Division.

Sgt. Stone was killed on March 3, 1969 while bravely serving our country in Vietnam.

He was posthumously awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor for conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity in action at the risk of his life above and beyond the call of duty.

To honor his memory, the State Legislature enacted Chapter 224 of the Laws of 2004 renaming a portion of State Route 79 in the Towns of Colesville and Windsor after Sgt. Stone.
